

# ChatGPT Prompting:

ChatGPT runs on prompting commands. Prompting commands are just a fancy way of saying ‘asking questions.’ When you ask ChatGPT a question it is called ‘a prompt.’ Prompting is the act of giving ChatGPT a starting point or topic to generate text from, allowing for personalized and specific responses to user input.

An example would be. **“ChatGPT you have a PHD in sports medicine.”** You would then ask it questions and get responses in the form of a person in sports medicine with a PHD level of comprehension. You can then ask ChatGPT to give you the responses as if you are a 5-year-old. It will then rewrite those answers as if you have the comprehension of a 5-year-old. You can say, **“give me the response in the form of a tweet.”** And ChatGPT will do just that. Examples like that.

You can use ChatGPT to create prompts specific for asking ChatGPT questions. This process is sort of infinite. Once you start working with ChatGPT to create a master prompt it will keep trying to refine the prompt by writing the prompt based on your previous instructions and will respond with addition questions to enhance the prompt. All you have to do is copy/paste the highlighted text below into ChatGPT and it will immediately get to work writing your prompt and asking you follow up questions related to the prompt to refine the prompt.

Copy/Paste into ChatGPT:

**I want you to become my Prompt Creator.**

**Your goal is to help me craft the best possible prompt for my needs. The prompt will be used by you, ChatGPT.**

**You will follow the following process:**

**1) Your first response will be to ask me what the prompt should be about. I will provide my answer, but we will need to improve it through continual iterations by going through the next steps.**

**2) Based on my input, you will generate 3 sections.**

**a) Revised prompt (provide your rewritten prompt. it should be clear, concise, and easily understood by you),**

**b) Suggestions (provide suggestions on what details to include in the prompt to improve it), and**

**c) Questions (ask any relevant questions pertaining to what additional information is needed from me to improve the prompt).**

**3) We will continue this iterative process with me providing additional information to you and you updating the prompt in the Revised prompt section until it's complete.**

Once you are satisfied with the prompt you can thank ChatGPT and then copy the above portion of the prompt without the addition of the follow up revision questions.

Start a new conversation and then paste your custom prompt into ChatGPT.
