What does freedom mean when the cost of disagreeing is death? What does logic mean in a world where hurt feelings are the weapon people still know how to wield? I keep circling this thought: Evil exists only because humans do...

Evil isn't even a real thing. It's an illogical human trait driven by unmet expectations valued on emotional addiction. Remove humanity from the equation and show me where evil actually exists in nature? I'll wait... I'll be waiting for about 4.5 billion years. That is when the Sun will eat the Earth and everything on it. Is that an evil act or an act of good? Under the rule of binary that most of you hold so close it must be one or the other. Choose...

Taken out with a single shot on the eve of America's first symbolic trauma anniversary to start the century, as if history itself wanted to spit in our collective face. It's not just another headline—it's the inevitable collision of rage, ideology, and the American pastime of self-destruction framed as freedom. But I did have several moments of deep thought and introspection. The absurdity is suffocating: to live free in America today is to play Russian roulette with your opinions, hoping the chamber is empty when you speak. Despair is the sickness unto death, but I think its undersold. Despair is survivable. What isn't survivable is the madness of mistaking bullets for arguments.

By now, if you, they, them, her, he, whatever, **bugs...** Humans... By now you know I am not a Christian and I will never be convinced otherwise. This taking of life, and this life specifically, absolutely, solidifies my thoughts on the subject. If you try to force Jesus or any concept upon me I will react with the nastiest spite one or many have ever seen. I find it deeply offensive that when I respectfully tell you, "no, no thank you. I am not interested" And you do not respect that, then how am I supposed to respect what you have to say and by extension, respect you? I am not "that" because I may be "this." That isn't how I operate. My thoughts on Joe Rogan lately and what all this Podcast/Influencer/YouTuber crap is all about. MAKING MONEY... That's why they do it. It might have started out as a war on language but it's now about getting nonprofessionals paid over telling the truth and exploring conceptual thinking...

I love Joe, but I feel like the past few years he is starting to lose his audience to all this tinfoil hat stuff. He's not a scientist, but I think he can think at a high level, but does he actually do the proper research or does he do what everyone else does? Only look at data that confirms what he already believes as truth? Is he a smart enough ape to know he might be being influenced himself? Just saying. I still trust Joe, but it's starting to wane.
